Special Rules

- To capture the “Those are regulars, by God” spirit (with British forces allegedly caught off guard facing well-trained American troops), the American side could “claim” two cards flipped for the British in the first turn, using them as if they were American instead of British cards. The American side decides which cards are “stolen” after they’re flipped.
- Variably sized units take part in this battle, some large and some small. The “Brigading Units” rule (ATKM 2nd ed, p. 23) applies once the battle begins based on normal unit sizes.
- The “Woodland Indians” rules (ATKM 2nd ed, p. 25) apply to the warbands on both sides
